

**Cattle for Christ was incorporated in June 2001 as a 501(c)(3) non-profit ministry whose goal is to unite Cattlemen and the Ag Industry for the purpose of taking the Gospel and the love of Christ Jesus to the world—especially among the poor and the unreached/under-reached peoples.**

**For the first six years, our funding came mainly from cattlemen who would sell a cow or calf each year and give us the proceeds to do mission work. In Dec 2007, we felt led to start a CCI cattle herd to broaden our outreach and to involve more people and industries in our global ministry efforts. Well, the Lord was sure in that. In just three years our herd grew to almost 300 head and we have never bought a cow!**

**However, with cattle prices as good as they are and with our limited personnel, time, land and resources, we decided that now is the time to turn our cattle into dollars for mission work. We hope that new cattle will be donated in the future and we are also keeping all of our carrier cattle to rebuild our herd through ET work. Our marketing strategy is to have a “Moving ‘Em Out for Missions Sale” every 3-4 years or as the Lord rebuilds our herd.**

**Since 2001, we have shared the Gospel and love of Christ with countless people, have helped train hundreds of pastors and children’s workers, helped feed and educate hundreds of children, helped provide sources of clean drinking water in remote villages, distributed thousands of Bibles, helped plant numerous churches, taught trades to create jobs for single mothers, and many other life changing ministries around the world. In 2010 alone, with the help of our donors and ministry partners, Cattle for Christ was able to support Christian mission work in 21 countries.**

**In 2009 we also started providing supplies, training, and genetic material to teach remote cattlemen the techniques of AI, ET and general herd management practices. This training helps them to quickly improve their cattle genetics and increase their production of meat, milk, butter and cheese—providing the nutrition and finances to help them meet the spiritual and physical needs of their own people. We shipped 12,000 straws of Angus semen to introduce Angus genetics to Peru in 2010. We hope to send Angus embryos in 2011 to start the first purebred Angus herd in the country of Peru.**

**Yet, there is still so much more to be done—so many who need to know the love and salvation of Jesus. So many who need to be taught Biblical principles of loving and providing for their family and developing good work ethics so that they can provide for themselves and help meet the needs of others.**

**We come to this sale knowing that nobody owes us anything—we are indebted to you. We have done all we can to produce the kind of genetics and performance cattle that will be an asset to any herd and we hope you will be pleased with our offering. All of the proceeds from our sale will go back to the ministry to support our mission work both here and around the world. As with all the money given to CCI for missions, not one dime goes to my personal salary.**

We are so grateful for all of you who support our work financially, who have donated cattle and resources for the herd, and for those who have donated their time, talents and resources to make this sale a success.
